
#### Intellectual Virtues and Collaboration

- Can Groups Have Intellectual Virtues?
  - Yes
    - Intuitively open minded groups vs open minded individuals
    - Empirically/Theoretically Wooley (CQ), Cheruvilil (high-performing teams)
- How do Group Intellectual Virtues relate to Individual Intellectual Virtues?
  - Some Group Intellectual Virtues are -
    - Not Reducible (again with the open minded example)
    - Unique (distinct from Individual Intellectual Virtues) more on this on the next slide

#### Group Intellectual Virtues – An example

- Integration
  - A team has the virtue of *integration* when it's capacities are
    - Synergistic
    - Efficient the synergy serves the purposes of the group
- A Story about Great School Architecture
  - Colorado State Institute for the Built Environment





#### **Integration Paradox**
