Chrome Browser Settings for Hubilo

Please note, use of the **Google Chrome browser** is required for Hubilo. If you do not have Chrome, please take a minute to download and install it.

Also, for Mac users it will be important to make sure that Chrome permissions are correctly set at the system level. See below for update instructions. Again, this should be done prior to launching Chrome for Hubilo sessions.

Mac Users

Before you open Chrome to access Hubilo you need to change Chrome permissions at the system settings level.

1. Open System Preferences and click "Security and Privacy".



2. Then select the "Privacy" tab. Make sure that the Google Chrome.app checkbox is activated to enable Chrome "to record the contents of your screen, even while using other apps." You may need to click the unlock icon in the bottom-left. See second on right.
